DORMITORY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Minimum five-weekly payments must be made in advance** (or in full for bookings under five weeks' duration).
- Booking Confirmation:** Bookings can only be confirmed if application is made and payment is received, inclusive of the application fee and bond, prior to check-in. Without prior application and/or payment, accommodation cannot be guaranteed and the casual rate will apply. All bookings and extensions are subject to room availability and will be accepted for a maximum period of 52 weeks.
- Application Fee:** This \$120.00 fee is refundable for non-arrivals and is charged for first time bookings only.
- Bond:** Dormitory payments must include the bond of NZ\$500.00 which will be refunded upon departure from the dormitory if all requirements have been complied with.
- Cancellation Fee:** A NZ\$200.00 fee will be charged for students who cancel dormitory bookings less than two weeks prior to expected check-in. The balance of any amount pre-paid is refundable/transferable.
- Extensions:** Requests for extensions must be made not less than two weeks prior to the payment period expiry date.
- Dormitory Check-out:** A minimum of two weeks' written notice must be given prior to departure. Payment for the cancellation notice period is non-refundable/non-transferable. Payment for the first five weeks' dormitory accommodation is non-refundable/non-transferable after arrival.
- Dormitory Residency Agreement:** Following booking confirmation and prior to or upon check-in, students will be required to sign a Dormitory Residency Agreement. The agreement can be viewed on the AIS website (<https://www.ais.ac.nz/student-life/accommodation>).

HOMESTAY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Minimum two-weekly payments must be made in advance.**
2. **Booking Confirmation:** Bookings can only be confirmed if application is made and payment is received, inclusive of the arrangement fee, prior to check-in. Without prior application and/or payment, accommodation cannot be guaranteed.
3. **Arrangement Fee:** This fee of NZ\$400.00 will cover one homestay arrangement only. If subsequent homestay arrangements are required, a fee of NZ\$250.00 will be charged for each new arrangement. Arrangement fees must be paid in advance.
4. **Cancellation Fee:** 100% of the Homestay Arrangement Fee will be charged for students who cancel homestay accommodation less than two weeks prior to expected check-in. The balance of any amount pre-paid is refundable/transferable.
5. **Homestay Check-Out:** For homestay accommodation of four weeks or more, a minimum of two weeks' written notice must be given prior to departure from the homestay. Where less than four weeks' homestay accommodation is booked, a minimum of one week's written notice must be given. Payment for the first two weeks of homestay accommodation is non-refundable/non-transferable after arrival.
6. **Homestay Meals:** Homestay accommodation includes two meals per day plus light lunches at weekends and on public holidays.
