

### Internship Option

An internship option of 8 to 12 weeks (240 hours placement) is also available onshore. This course, **BUAD920 Internship** is weighted as two taught courses, or 30 credits. When selecting the internship option, only two elective courses are to be selected.

This is also an entry pathway for candidates that don't meet the two years of relevant work experience entry requirement. Candidates taking this option must have a degree or postgraduate qualification in cognate business disciplines.
